- Research: Research of a community-based organization and a variety of text and web-based material is required of all students. This research will assist students in designing, implementing, and evaluating their service-learning project.
- <u>Fieldwork</u>: Fieldwork consists of hands-on experience and the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the real-life challenges and successes of community-cultural development. Fieldwork will require on-site contact with specific communities or community-based organizations.
- <u>Journal</u>: A journal with notes, field notes, research, and personal reflection is required. Reflection is at the heart of learning and an integral part of service-learning curriculum. The journal will consist of critical reflection on what the student has learned and experienced through research and reading, site visits, and discussions with the site supervisor and faculty sponsor.
- <u>Narrative Reflection and Assessment</u>: Based on research and experience in the field, this final assessment will reflect on the service-learning design, execution, and outcomes and demonstrate the student's knowledge of community-cultural development.
- The <u>Time Commitment</u> is 6 hours per week usually a combination of working with the faculty supervisor to develop the project, conducting independent research and planning, and working on-site to implement the project.
